Experiential have had another busy week over zoom and garden play sessions. Here is one example:






Michelle and Elaine planned and resourced this 'under the sea' session - they've been busy painting sewing & laminating !!! ... and Brayden loved it!

The teachers in the Exploratory phase have met (virtually) this week to ensure learners' PLPs are ready for their new classes in September.












# **Investigative Phase**
