Our school will:

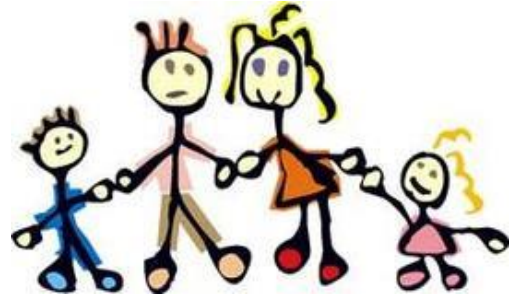
- ✚ Encourage your child to become an active member within our community and help them to see that they can have an impact on the world around them.
